Key themes

This workshop explores the impact of the Romans in Britain.

Using real and replica objects, hands-on activities and dress-up material, including a child-sized suit of Roman armour, pupils will:

- Discover what the Romans brought to Britain new technology, foods, and clothes
- Explore Roman lifestyles, art and beliefs
- Find out why the Roman army was so successful
- Discover more about the Romans in the local area

Learning Outcomes

- Understanding why the Romans were so advanced
- Appreciating the impact their arrival had on the Celts in Britain
- Developing skills in questioning, imagining, thinking critically and evaluating
- Improving knowledge of chronology
- Learning new vocabulary and skills
